

Medical Gas Systems ASSE 6040 Maintenance Personnel Certification Course

Description: This course is for any individual who maintains medical gas and vacuum systems. Healthcare facility personnel installing medical gas or vacuum systems shall be certified to ASSE Standard 6010. Medical gas systems include vacuum piping. This is an ASSE 6040, 32-hour training course including a written and practical examination.

Course areas of study will be:

- **General Knowledge:** Identify and show knowledge of applicable laws, rules, codes, listing agencies, federal and state regulations.
- **Product Performance:** Identify the major components of medical gas and vacuum systems, and operating principals.
- **Product Maintenance Knowledge:** Identify and describe proper maintenance requirements for medical gas and vacuum systems.
- **System and System Component Testing:** Test procedures for system components.
- **Documenting and Recording:** Identify location of equipment and report on status.
- **Administration:** Record Keeping
- **Storage & Handling of Medical Gas Cylinders**

Prerequisites: Individuals must be employed by a health care facility with a minimum of one (1) year of hospital maintenance experience.

Course Objectives:

- To provide minimum performance criteria for medical gas and vacuum system maintenance personnel, to assure compliance with industry standards, federal and state regulations.
